Belmore's Speech Pathologists help to develop a range of skills in functional communication including use of language, speech, literacy and social skills. Students can explore both electronic and non electronic communication systems, with opportunities to expand and develop autonomous communication with all people in their environment.

Mealtimes assessment and supervision are crucial to lunchtimes at Belmore School. The speech pathology teamwork to ensure students are safe and engaged, and offer an opportunity to develop their oral motor and sensory skills for mealtimes.

All programs at Belmore are individually tailored for students and developed in line with their Individual Education Plans. All speech pathology supports are implemented in consultation with families, external providers in the community and the team around the learner, ensuring continuity and opportunities for student success.
